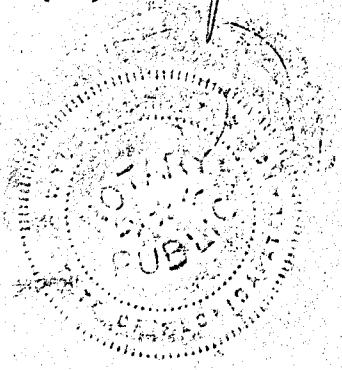

RESOLUTION VACATING ALLEY

WHEREAS, application has been made to the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, for the vacation, abrogation and closing that certain Alley in Marion County, Florida, hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, notice of such application was duly published in the Ocala Star Banner as required by Section 336.10, Florida Statutes, 1969, and public hearing was held thereon by the Board of County Commissioners at 10:00 o'clock A.M. on June 1, 1971, at which time action on the application was deferred to June 16, 1971, and

WHEREAS, it appears that said alley has never been opened or used by the public and is not now required for use for public utilities or any other purpose by Marion County; and

WHEREAS, it further appears that no objection has been raised by adjoining landowners or otherwise to said abrogation, and that it would be in the best interest of the County of Marion to abrogate and close said alley;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, in regular session as follows:

1. The Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, do hereby abrogate, vacate and close the following described alley:

"That certain Alley lying on the Western boundary of FORE ACRES as per map or plat thereof recorded in Plat Book "H", at Page 3 of the Public Records of Marion County, Florida, the said Alley be bounded on the South by the South boundary of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (Ne $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 33, Township 14 South, Range

22 East, bounded on the North by the right-of-way of Northeast 49th Street (Fore Road), bounded on the East by Block "B" of FORE ACRES and bounded on the West by the West boundary of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 33, Township 14 South, Range 22 East."


