RESOLUTION

CLOSING AND VACATING THAT PORTION OF NORTHEAST 20th AVENUE LYING BETWEEN LOT 11, BLOCK "B", AND LOT 1, BLOCK "F", OF FORE ACRES SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, the owners of all of the above lands abutting on the hereinafter-described portion of Northeast 20th Avenue filed their Petition before the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, seeking the closing and vacating of said road; and

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing concerning said Petition was duly published in the newspaper of general circulation, namely, The Ocala Star-Banner, at least two weeks prior to said hearing date, namely, May 20th, 1969; and

WHEREAS, in regular meeting assembled on Tuesday, May 20th, 1969, a public hearing was held to consider the advisability of closing and vacating said road; at said hearing it was found and determined by the Board of County Commissioners that said road should be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, at a regular meeting assembled that that portion of Northeast 20th Avenue lying between Lot 11, Block "B", and Lot 1, Block "F", of Fore Acres Subdivision, as per plat thereof recorded in Plat Book "H", Page 3, Public Records of Marion County, Florida, be, and the same is, closed and vacated, and any right of Marion County, Florida, and the public in and to that said portion of said road be, and the same is hereby, renounced and disclaimed; and that title to said portion of said public road be, and the same is, vested in the abutting fee owners, all pursuant to provisions of Florida Statutes, Sections 336.09-336.12.
